Board of Directors Expectations

The Mission of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation is to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research.

Board of Directors term of service: Two (2) years with maximum of three (3) consecutive terms

The Board of Directors is responsible for providing leadership and implementing policy for the organization. Each Board member is expected to contribute significant time and energy to the organization by fulfilling each of the following areas:

1. Contribute credibility, visibility, expertise and/or contacts to the organization by virtue of one's position in the community.
2. Become a member of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation International (JDRFI) and renew membership annually. This can be accomplished online at [www.jdrf.org](http://www.jdrf.org).
3. Sign the JDRF's Code of Ethics Policy.
4. Attend a majority of the Board meetings each year, including the Chapter's Annual Meeting. No member is permitted to miss two or more consecutive Board meetings.
5. Submit an annual evaluation in, or close to, the month of April of his/her performance as a Board member, as well as an evaluation of the Board's performance as a whole.
6. Attend as many of major/core fundraising Chapter events as possible.
7. Serve on at least one standing committee of the Board.
8. Register as a JDRF Advocate. Generate letters or make personal visits to his/her elected officials on an as needed basis or as recommended by the Government Relations Committee. This can be accomplished online at [www.jdrf.org](http://www.jdrf.org).
9. Personally contribute or raise a minimum of \$5,000 annually.
